

Man achte bei den Etüden 9 bis 14 sowohl auf die klar zu spielenden Zerlegungen in der Mittelstimme als auch auf gute Melodie- und Baßführung.

In studies 9 to 14 pay special attention to keeping the broken chords in the middle part clear and to playing the melody and the bass part accurately.
