


# Escala Hexatónica dominante #11 | Dominant #11 Hexatónica scale



Practica estas 4 escalas y sus 5 digitaciones con el siguiente patrón. Este ejemplo está en la forma Sol de la escala hexatónica Flamenco mayor. Primero con el pulgar a corcheas, luego picando tresillos y semicorcheas.

Practice these four scales and their five fingerings with the following pattern. Play it first with the thumb and in eighth notes, then picking *i m i m* in triplets and sixteenth notes. This example is in the G form of the flamenco major hexatonic scale.
